<p>Reading</p> 	<p>15 minutes daily using either their 'reading practice book' from school or a school library book (also called a 'reading for pleasure book').</p> <p>Please remember to sign your child's yellow reading diary.</p> <p>Please send your child's reading book into school to be changed every Monday and Thursday.</p>
<p>Phonics</p>	<p>We use 'Little Wandle Letters & Sounds' to teach phonics. Guidance about GPCs & tricky words taught in class is provided each week for you to reinforce at home.</p>
<p>Spellings</p> 	<p>Weekly spellings are set weekly. These can be found on your child's 'Class Dojo Portfolio' page. Please do practise a little each day to embed learning.</p>
<p>English (Ninja Words)</p> 	<p>The Word of the Day helps to develop a clear system of consistency and progression to embed vocabulary. Each week the children will look at three new words in class, discussing their meaning, and the number of syllables it contains, etc. Every Thursday your child will receive the words we have explored in class to consolidate their learning at home. Please talk to your child about the words. (Talking is more important than recording!) Please note that we will not have covered Friday's word until the next day. There is an <u>optional</u> activity sheet that you might like to complete at home. This can be shared via the Class Dojo. (Please upload work for only one word!)</p>
<p>Mathematics</p> 	<p>To consolidate learning in class, your child will be set a practical task each week. This may be an active maths activity or a game, e.g. dice game or a link to an online game.</p>
