<p>Reading</p> 	<p>10-15 minutes daily using either their reading book from school or a book they are reading for pleasure from home or the local library.</p> <p>Please remember to sign your child's yellow reading diary (books will not be changed unless signed).</p> <p>Please send your child's reading book into school to be changed every Thursday. Library books should be brought into school every Tuesday. Unfortunately, books cannot be changed on other days</p>
<p>Spellings</p> 	<p>These will be phased in and will be linked to our 'Little Wandle Letters and Sounds' scheme.</p> <p>More information to follow nearer to the time.</p>
<p>English</p> 	<p>The Word of the Day (Ninja Words) help to develop a clear system of consistency and progression to embed vocabulary. Each week the children will look at three new words in class, discussing their meaning, and the number of syllables it contains, etc. Every Thursday your child will receive the words as part of homework that we have explored in class to consolidate at home. Please talk to your child about the words. Please note that we may not have covered all the words before Friday. There will be an <u>optional</u> activity sheet that you might like to complete at home. This can be shared via the Class Dojo. If you choose to do this, please upload work for only ONE word! Talking about the words is more important than recording!</p>
<p>Mathematics</p> 	<p>To consolidate learning in class, your child will be set a practical task each week. This may be an active maths activity or a game, e.g. dice game or a link to an online game.</p>
