



## Remote Learning Policy (Parents & Pupils)

Staff expect pupils to:

- Access Class Dojo with daily work.
- Be contactable during the school day – although consider they may not always be in front of a device the entire time
- Complete work to the deadline set by teachers and respond to feedback on Class Dojo
- Seek help if they need it but understand that feedback cannot be immediate
- Alert teachers if they're not able to complete work

Staff expect parents with children learning remotely to:

- Make the school aware if their child is sick or otherwise can't complete work
- Seek help from the school if they need it - email is the best form of communication in these circumstances
- Be respectful when making any complaints or concerns known to staff

### **Monitoring arrangements**

This policy will be reviewed annually in usual circumstances. During the Covid pandemic it will be reviewed after each period of lockdown that enforces remote learning. At every review, it will be approved by the chair of Governors Mr James Spark.

**Update September 2021** – under new guidance remote learning will only be uploaded to Class Dojo on the presentation of a positive Covid-19 PCR test result for the pupil and for the duration of their 10 day isolation period.
