Year 5

<p>Reading</p> 	<p>20 minutes daily using either their reading book, or a book they are reading for pleasure from home or the local library.</p> <p>Please remember to sign your child's reading diary</p> <p>Please send your child's reading book into school to be changed every Monday or Thursday.</p>
<p>Timestables</p> 	<p>Please support your child in practising their times tables.</p> <p>https://ttrockstars.com/</p>
<p>Spellings</p> 	<p>Each week your child will receive spellings to learn for a test on Thursday morning. These will follow a specific spelling rule taken from the Year 5 curriculum following the sequence on Spelling Shed. Games will be added to spelling shed each week so that your child can practise. https://play.edshed.com</p>
<p>English</p> 	<p>The Vocab Ninja Word of the Day helps to develop a clear system of consistency and progression to embed vocabulary. Each day the children will look at a new word in class, discussing its meaning, word class and the number of syllables it contains amongst other things. Every Friday your child will receive the words we have explored in class via Class Dojo to consolidate their learning at home.</p>
<p>Mathematics</p> 	<p>Your child will be set an activity on MyMaths each week to complete online.</p> <p>https://login.mymaths.co.uk/login</p> <p>An additional piece of more challenging Maths will usually be provided but this is completely optional.</p>
<p>English Task</p>	<p>Each week, your child will be set an English task to complete. This could be in the form of a piece of writing, a comprehension or a piece of grammar and punctuation work.</p>

Children in Year 5 should aim to spend a maximum of 3 hours per week in total. Homework will be set on Fridays and will be due to be completed by the following Thursday. Completed tasks should be photographed and uploaded on Class Dojo Portfolio.
