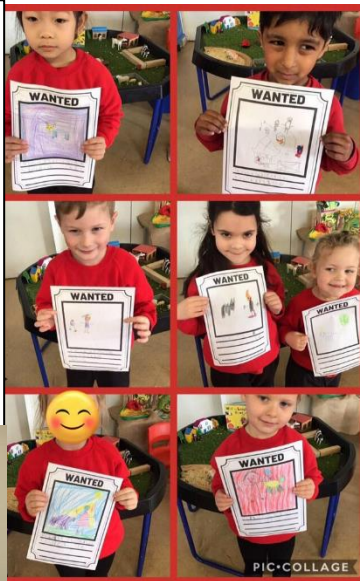




Welcome to the Cloverlea Primary Curriculum Snapshot - a monthly page to let our parents know what is happening at the school.
